- **In the Air:** RC-135, JSF, F-15, F-16, F-22, Global Hawk, Predator
- **In Space:** Mars Rover, SM-3, EKV, Deep Space Probe
- **Commercial:** Airbus, Camera Stabilization (WESCAM)
